

RIDES TO HIGH SCHOOL CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP

We try to offer some rides to High School Christian Fellowship and our Sunday night Bible study. The van is meant to provide a ride for students who have no other way to a Christian Fellowship event. There are some things we want students who are asking for a ride, and especially their parents, to know.

- “CF” or “Christian Fellowship” is actually Bloomingdale Christian Fellowship. We are a non-profit Christian organization that seeks to bring the Gospel of Jesus Christ to teens, ie, we want them to come to know God through His Son Jesus Christ.
- We are not a church. We do not want to take young people away from their family’s church to attend our meetings. In fact, we encourage young people who get involved with us to also start attending a church. Church lasts for a lifetime and beyond, CF lasts through high school.
- Students who ride with us need to practice safe and courteous van riding. That means among other things: always wear a seat belt, always sit in the seat closest to the front of the van, do not throw things in the van, do not leave trash in the van and keep the volume of your voice to a normal conversational level.
- Make sure you tell the van driver where you live and make sure you are sitting near the front of the van when we are coming to your house.
- **You can request a ride to CF on Wednesday before Wednesday – so by Tuesday night around 9:00. Late Tuesday night we make our van route and publish it on Facebook. You can request a ride to Bible study before 4:00 p.m. Sunday.**
- We try to get students home within one hour of the time the van is loaded. Normally that should be within ten minutes of the end of our meeting but sometimes students do not cooperate with loading the van in a timely fashion.
- We are always going to do our best to operate our vans in a safe manner. When roads become slick, it is going to take us longer to complete our van route. Sometimes a lot longer, but safety first!
- The Bloomingdale Public School District is a very large school district. We are not able to give rides everywhere within our district. Right now our van route goes from Bloomingdale, north on 46<sup>th</sup> Street to 109<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Pullman, then south on 56<sup>th</sup> Street to Grand Junction and then back to Bloomingdale. We can go a short way off of that route but we cannot go far and still get everyone home within the time we try to deliver. Sorry. Wish we had more drivers.
